### **LECTURE PRESENTS A GEOPHYSICS VIEW OF CLIMATE CHANGE**

Thomas H. Jordan, the W.M. Keck Professor of Earth Sciences at the University of Southern California and director of the Southern California Earthquake Center, will give the 2006 J. Tuzo Wilson Lecture at the University of Toronto on Monday, November 27 on the topic Civilization as a Geosystem: A Scientific Perspective on Global Change.
